Note: No alternates from any state will be allowed to compete in the tournament. Only wrestlers officially entered by the deadline date (Sunday, Feb 25th, 12 PM) may compete.

- C. **Please Note:** There will be no New England wrestling alternates. Please do not bring alternates to the tournament or list them on your entry sheet.
- D. There will be no appeal with regard to official entries. The list that is submitted is final. There will be no changes or additions once the official list is submitted.
- E. Pigtail wrestlers will be moved to fill the bracket when necessary. The tournament coordinator has final say on the movement of wrestlers. His decision will be final with no appeal. His professional judgment will be honored.

SEEDING AND RELATED INFO (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY):

1. Brockton High School (MA) Coach Jim Maher designed the seeding chart. This chart has been used since 1999. Mr. William Wassell (MA) made minor changes in 2003.
2. There are 196 first round bouts. This includes the pigtail round. Please have your wrestlers ready.
3. Each weight class has a 22-man bracket. Each weight class will have 6 pigtail bouts. Pigtail bouts are non-scoring.

ARRIVAL:

Please do not arrive at the gym prior to 3:00 PM on Friday and 9 AM on Saturday. Please do not come early, as you will not be allowed entry. The gym will not be available on Thursday.

ENTRY FEE:

Entry fee: \$15 per wrestler. Pay \$15 to registration clerk and receive official weigh-in card.
NO weigh-in unless \$15 fee is paid. Make checks payable to: **NEW ENGLAND COUNCIL**
NO REFUNDS — Receipts available upon request.

Each registered wrestler will receive a beautiful New England Tournament pin and an attractive certificate of participation.

PASSES:

Only qualified wrestlers and their coaches (maximum of 2) will be admitted without charge.

RULES:

National Federation Rules, 14 weight classes.
No weigh-in on Saturday.
4 lb. weight allowance on Friday (example 103 = 107).
The New England Seeding Chart is used to place all wrestlers in the bracket.

SCORING:

Team scoring will start in the 16-man bracket. Scoring will be for the first 6 places.
Scoring: 16-12-9-7-5-3. We will wrestle for 6 places in each weight class.

CONSOLATIONS:

See Rule Book. Wrestlers who lose to a semifinalist are eligible for consolations. This includes pigtail wrestlers. Scoring and awards are for 6 places.

WRESTLING FORMAT:

Seven mats will be used to start on Friday night. Bouts will be assigned to mats continuously starting at the lowest weight class and working up. Every effort will be made to adhere to the time schedule.

AWARDS:

It is the coach's responsibility to have their wrestlers present and properly dressed for the awards ceremony, which will take place during the championship finals. There are trophies for the top three teams plus individual awards for the top 6 place finishers in each weight class. There is also an Outstanding Wrestler trophy, and an Outstanding Finals Bout award (both wrestlers receive). No awards will be given early.

ADMISSION:

Adults and Students: \$7.00 per session. There are three separate sessions: Friday PM, Saturday AM, and Saturday PM. A single day tournament pass is available for \$10.00 on Saturday, which provides entry for both Saturday sessions. Under school age is free with parent tournament or gate pass.

From I-95 North:

Take exit 44, take a right onto Kimberly Avenue. Follow Kimberly Avenue to your first light, take a left onto Ella Grasso Boulevard. Continue on the Boulevard until you cannot go any further. Then take a right onto Crescent Street. Field House will be 1/2 mile down on your left. As you proceed towards the field house make your first left onto Munson Street and then make your first left into the main parking lot.

From I-95 South

Take exit 45, take a right onto Ella Grasso Boulevard until you cannot go any further. Then take a right onto Crescent Street. Field House will be 1/2 mile down on your left. As you proceed towards the field house make your first left onto Munson Street and then make your first left into the main parking lot.

From I-91 South

Take the downtown New Haven exit, which is exit 1. That exit then becomes Frontage Road and you continue straight until you come up to exit 3. Continue through exit 3 and proceed straight until you cannot go any further. Take a right onto Ella Grasso Boulevard. Then continue straight for approximately 3 miles and continue straight until you cannot go anymore. Take a right onto Crescent Street. Field House will be 1/2 mile down on your left. As you proceed towards the field house make your first left onto Munson Street and then make your first left into the main parking lot.

From Route 15 (Wilbur Cross Parkway)

Take exit 59, take a right onto Whalley Avenue (toward New Haven). Then turn left onto Ella Grasso Boulevard. Continue straight until the end and then make a right onto Crescent Street. Field House will be 1/2 mile down on your left. As you proceed towards the field house, make your first left into the main parking lot.

From Route 15 South

Take exit 60, take a right onto Dixwell Avenue. Continue on Dixwell Avenue until you see Stop & Shop on the left and Dunkin Donuts on your right. At the light (St. Ann's Church) make a right onto Arch Street. Then make a left onto Bowen Street. After you see the baseball field on your right you then make a right onto Munson Street and make your first right into the main parking lot.
